


## **AIDSVu June Launch Data Update**

On June 27, 2014, AIDSVu is releasing its June launch with city maps detailing 2011 data and a number of improved site functionalities. This document provides an overview of the update to help you share the AIDSVu maps with your networks.

## **Major Data Enhancements**

- ZIP code level maps for 33 U.S. cities using 2011 data:
  - New maps for 11 cities Baton Rouge, LA; Boston, MA; Bridgeport-Stamford-Norwalk, CT;
    Columbia, SC; Jackson, MS; Jacksonville, FL; Milwaukee-Waukesha-West Allis, WI; Newark,
    New Haven-Milford, NJ; Oakland, CA; and Richmond, VA
  - Updated maps for 22 cities Atlanta, GA; Charlotte, NC; Chicago, IL; Dallas, TX; Denver, CO; Detroit, MI; Ft. Lauderdale, FL; Hampton Roads, VA; Houston, TX; Los Angeles County; Memphis, TN; Miami, FL; New Orleans, LA; New York City; Orlando, FL; Palm Beach, FL; Philadelphia, PA; San Diego, CA; San Francisco, CA; San Juan, PR; Tampa, FL; and Washington, D.C.



- Updated city profile pages for 27 U.S. cities, including 10 new cities
- New interactive maps displaying HIV prevalence data by census tract for Chicago, and updated census tract maps for Philadelphia and Washington, D.C.



- Updated HIV prevalence maps alongside social determinants of health - poverty, median household income, and educational attainment and income inequality - in side-by-side map views for 33 cities
- Updated HIV testing and treatment locator maps, including NIH-funded HIV prevention, vaccine and treatment trials locations viewable on AIDSVu's interactive maps

## **Major Functionality Enhancements**

- New downloadable and printable resources
  - Updated slide decks for all 33 AIDSVu cities
  - Updated data-for-download for all cities who authorize availability of data on AIDSVu
  - Updated data methods
- Improved website functionality for search, navigation and news.

- New neighborhood mapping pilot with community level maps for Chicago and ward-level maps for Washington, D.C.
- Updated national map with state-level and county-level data for those living with HIV through 2011
- County-level new diagnosis data for those diagnosed with HIV from 2008-2012
