

Social Determinants of Health and HIV Among Women

In 2019, **women** made up **20% of all new HIV diagnoses** in the U.S.

Social determinants of health such as **poverty, education, insurance, and unemployment** can **negatively impact HIV-related health outcomes for women**, especially **women of color** and **transgender women**.



Poverty

American Community Survey, 2018



14.3% of **women** were living in poverty.



13.1% of **U.S. population** were living in poverty.

11.9% of **men** were living in poverty.



Uninsured

American Community Survey, 2018



7.9% of **women** were uninsured.



10% of **U.S. population*** were uninsured.

**The U.S. population statistics represent Americans under 65.*



9.9% of **men** were uninsured.

Unemployment

U.S. Department of Labor, 2018



3.8% of **women** were unemployed.



3.9% of **U.S. population** were unemployed.



3.9% of **men** were unemployed.

Education

American Community Survey, 2018



89.2% of **women** had at least a high school education.



88.8% of **U.S. population** had at least a high school education



88% of **men** had at least a high school education.
