
Social Determinants of Health and HIV Among Asians, Native Hawaiians, and Pacific Islanders

In 2019, Asians, Native Hawaiians, and Pacific Islanders (NHPI) represented 2.2% (796) of all new HIV diagnoses in the U.S.

Social determinants of health such as poverty, insurance, education, and unemployment can negatively affect HIV-related health outcomes for Asians, Native Hawaiians, and Pacific Islanders.








87.6% of Asian people had at least a high school education.



87.2% of Native Hawaiians/Pacific Islanders had at least a high school education.



5.3% of Native Hawaiians/Pacific **Islanders** were unemployed.
